## Introduction

In this document, we will share the details of OpenCV Gold Membership and how it can benefit your organization.

The OpenCV library is the largest open source computer vision library in the world. It is a collection of more than 2500 optimized algorithms and is downloaded 30 million times per month across Python and C++ versions.

OpenCV.org is a non-profit foundation that maintains the OpenCV library. It is currently supported by its Membership programs, courseware, and partnership programs.

OpenCV is a 501(c)3 registered non-profit organization in the United States. Donations to OpenCV are likely deductible in the United States.

## Gold Membership

The Gold Membership is the highest membership level for OpenCV.org. This Membership is right for companies that are committed to open source and want to actively participate in the development of OpenCV library through donation of cash, development resources, and other forms of support. It is perfect for companies looking to expand their reach, prestige, and visibility in the computer vision and AI community.

### Donations

OpenCV Gold Membership for the year 2025 requires a donation of \$100k in cash, developer time, or other resources. Memberships are active for the calendar year 2025.

### Benefits

The following benefits are extended to Gold Members as a courtesy.

#### Advisory Committee Seat

All Gold Members are eligible for a seat on the **OpenCV Advisory Committee**. This committee meets every 3 months and advises the technical team on focus areas, roadmap, standards, and features. The recommendations of the committee are seriously considered by the technical team for implementation but are not binding.



## Technical Support

Some Gold Members actively contribute to the OpenCV library to extend its capabilities. In case a Gold Sponsor requires support, OpenCV will make reasonable efforts to find a qualified consultant to help their project.

## Training Courses

Gold Members can contribute training material to OpenCV courses. The material will need to adhere to the format laid down by the course team. For paid courses, an additional revenue sharing contract is signed. For free courses, OpenCV will charge a maintenance fee.

If a Gold Sponsor wants to create training material but does not have the necessary expertise, OpenCV will assist in finding third party contractors.

## Pull Request Priority

A library pull request on GitHub recommended by a Gold member receives higher priority for consideration over other pull requests in the queue. The pull request must still be approved by the core team and needs to meet the same rigorous standards as any other pull request.

## Press Release

OpenCV.org will do a press release publicly announcing new Gold members.

## Webinars / Live Streams

OpenCV organizes live webinars where top industry experts in computer vision and AI share their knowledge with the community. These webinars attract 150-200 simultaneous viewers and 1200-2000 total live viewers who watch some part of the show.

Gold Members have the option of having one of their team members on up to 3 webinars per year. The team member and the topic would need to be approved by OpenCV.

These webinars will be publicized using OpenCV newsletters, official blog, and social media accounts on YouTube, LinkedIn, Mastodon and Bluesky.

## Email Newsletter

New products and/or services related to computer vision and/or AI by Gold members may be included in OpenCV's newsletters 4 times per year. OpenCV newsletters reach over 300,000 subscribers across standard email and LinkedIn editions.



## Website Mention

The Gold Members are prominently displayed on the main page of the OpenCV.org website.

## OpenCV Logo

The Gold Members are permitted to display the OpenCV Gold Membership Logo on their website. The Gold Members are not permitted to use the OpenCV logo or the OpenCV Gold Membership Logo to promote a product or service.

## Conference Booth Display

Member logos are prominently displayed at conferences where OpenCV.org has a booth. Since 2023, OpenCV has had a booth at the Embedded Vision Summit and at Computer Vision and Pattern recognition (CVPR) conference.

## Blog Posts

Gold members are invited to write 4 educational blog posts per year for the OpenCV community to be posted on the OpenCV.org blog. These posts will be publicized using OpenCV newsletters, and social media accounts. The posts need to provide real value to the OpenCV community and should not be a simple product promotion. The member company will however be provided clearly designated space where they can add a blurb and link back to their company site. These posts will need to be approved by OpenCV's editorial staff.

## Tutorials

Gold Members are invited to host a tutorial for their products or services at opencv.org.
